

## Research Project

Doctoral research student Ps. Astrid Staley a candidate of the Australian Collage of Theology studying through the Melbourne School of Theology is seeking people who would like to participate in the research of postvention care in suicide bereavement.

- Eligibility Criteria:**
- \*Have lost a Christian family member to suicide.
  - \*Participant may or may not be presently affiliated with a church that identifies as Evangelical or Pentecostal, but was at the time of the tragedy.
  - \*Participant must be over 21 years.
  - \*Participant must reside in Victoria.
  - \*Participant can be male or female.
  - \*Participant must be able to speak English unaided by an interpreter.

**Purpose of Research:** To contribute and expand on the existing body of knowledge within the Christian community of how to effectively minister postvention care to suicide bereaved.

**Interview Process:** Informal 1x 1-2hour face-to-face interview at a place of the participant's choosing, with provision for follow up phone call, Skype or email to clarify any questions arising from the interview.
